Her program for the evening was, **Stream Water Quality as Determined by Indicator Species**. Though many species could be used for this study, her focus was on macro invertebrates that fall into 3 basic categories of Pollution Tolerance with varying levels within each category. From studies done on creeks in the Chicago area and Kane County, it has been found that many are generally in good condition. However, as we continue to develop properties in our watersheds and with the changes in climate, we need to stay involved if we are going to maintain the water quality of our streams. The program was very interesting and well received by the more than 30 people who attended the event. The Coalition gained 6 new members and one returning member.
