## Fox Water Trail Update

Karen Miller discussed efforts to work with the National Park Service over the past several years on creating a water trail for the Fox River. Five open houses were held last spring for public input on draft maps. Site visits were held to address comments and update maps as needed. Have been working on itineraries which will include various trail options with information on amenities, portage capabilities, etc. These will be included on the interactive website that is already up and running. Working on the final management plan to be submitted to the National Park Service.

#### **Sub Watershed News**

FREP provided outreach and information as part of the sub-watershed team for Mill Creek. Signed with CMAP to serve the same role with Indian Creek. Ultimate goal is to develop an official EPA approved action plan that would qualify for 319 grants under the Clean Water Act and to have this ready to put into action as needed.
